## 7 Dates and procedure of the competition

1. Works can be submitted from **December 1, 2021 to May 31, 2022** via the Internet at [www.schieleaward.at](http://www.schieleaward.at)
2. Invitations to the nominated artists will be issued by **June 30, 2022**.

3. **September 1, 2022:** Completion of the **exhibition catalog** analog and digital at [www.schieleaward.at](http://www.schieleaward.at).
4. **October 5 and 6, 2022: Delivery of the original works** for the exhibition. Delivery of the works to the following address: Minoritenkloster Tulln, Minoritenplatz 1, 3430 Tulln an der Donau. Should objects be sent by mail: City Hall of the City of Tulln, Attn: RC Tulln Schiele Award, Minoritenplatz 1, 3430 Tulln an der Donau.
5. **October 8 – November 11, 2022: Exhibition of the selected art objects in the Minorite Monastery of the City of Tulln, opening hours: Thurs-Sun from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day.**
6. **Friday, October 7, 2022, at 7 pm: Vernissage, awarding of the 3 jury prizes**
7. **Friday, November 11, 2022, at 7 pm: Finissage, auction of all unsold works. All artists are of course cordially invited to both the vernissage and the finissage.**
8. **From November 11 after finissage until November 13, 2022:** Return of unsold objects to the artists.

## 8 Prices

**1<sup>st</sup> prize € 5.000,-**  
**2<sup>nd</sup> prize € 3.000,-**  
**3<sup>rd</sup> prize € 2.000,-**

In addition, all nominated artists will receive 50 % of the proceeds from the sale or auction.

## 9 Catalog

The organizer RC Tulln will produce a catalog of all exhibited works. The nominated artists will receive 2 free copies.

## 10 Requirements for online submission

December 1, 2021 to May 31, 2022

The prerequisite for participation in the competition is the **fully completed online form at [www.schieleaward.at](http://www.schieleaward.at)**. All content requirements listed there must be observed! The photos must be uploaded for the catalog production in **appropriate quality (300 dpi/20x30cm, without frame or at least 2500 pixels in width and height)**, but must not exceed the specified **maximum file size (10 MB)**. Only the **file formats „jpg“ and „png“** are permitted. The file name must be structured as follows: Kuenstlernachname\_Titel.jpg or .png. In case there is no title name or the same title, a digit (1 or 2) must be added to distinguish it (e.g.: Surname\_oTitle2.jpg). The file names must not contain any special characters or spaces.

## 11 Requirements for the original works to be submitted

The works nominated by the jury must meet the following requirements upon delivery:

- The artists must unpack the packed works themselves in the presence of the curators. Curators, unpack the works themselves upon delivery or pack them upon collection. Should this not be possible RC Tulln assumes no liability.
- All works must be provided **with a suitable hanging device** for wall mounting or with any other necessary installation device.
- On the back or on a **label firmly attached to the artwork**, the following **mandatory information** must be provided for identification purposes:
  - **First and last name** of the artist
  - **Date of birth**
  - **Address, phone number, e-mail, website (optional)**
  - **Title/technique/format/year of creation**
  - **image of the work or images (jpg or png)**
  - **short description of the work**
  - **amount of the desired selling price**

The nominated works must be made available by the end of the exhibition on November 12, 2022.

## 12 Sales

Sales or the final auction on November 11, 2022 will be handled exclusively at the selling price stated by the artists, with **50 % of the selling price** benefiting the RC Tulln project „Families in Need“.

Artists are asked for their account information in order to receive the 50 % sales proceeds. **Prerequisite for this is an invoice or fee note to RC Tulln.**

## 13 Pick up/return

Submitted works that have not been sold or auctioned can be collected from November 11 after the finissage or by November 13. If the works are not collected by December 1, 2022, they will become the property of RC Tulln.

## 14 Insurance

The works are insured up to a value from a maximum of € 5,000. The insurance coverage begins at the time of delivery to the exhibition site (after unpacking by the artist) and ends at the time of collection or at the latest on 14. 11. 2022 (before packing by the artist). Unpacking and packing will be done by the artist him/herself. RC Tulln will supervise the artwork during the opening hours of the exhibition.

## 15 Publication and conditions

By participating in the competition, participants agree to the publication of all data and images provided by them in various media (catalog, film/TV, press reports, website, etc.). Participants agree to the terms and conditions of the competition and unconditionally agree to the exclusion of legal recourse. The organizer reserves the right to make adaptations and adjustments to the competition conditions at any time.

Egon Schiele is one of the most extraordinary artistic personalities of Viennese modernism. His expressive art has lost none of its fascination to this day.

Schiele was born in 1890 in Tulln on the Danube and spent the first 15 years of his life here. He died of the Spanish flu at the height of his artistic success at the age of only 28. In his short creative period, the artist produced a body of work that set a trend for posterity. Egon Schiele never abandoned representationalism. The figure, the human body was of great importance to him. At the center of his artistic interest was the reflection of his own existence, which Schiele expressed in countless self-portraits, but also in land- and cityscapes. From the aesthetics of the Fin de Siècle, Egon Schiele expressed the emergence of a new era. How are these dynamics negotiated artistically from today's perspective?
